12.11 Most ATP is made by oxidative phosphorylation on the *inner membrane*. Folding the inner membrane and having many mitochondria gives a much larger total membrane surface, so more oxidative phosphorylation can happen at once — letting an active muscle cell make a lot of ATP quickly.
