18.1 Sorts living things into groups by their shared features.

18.6 A species is defined as a group that can breed to produce *fertile* offspring. A horse and a donkey produce a mule, but the mule is *infertile*, so the cross does not meet that definition — which is why the horse and donkey are classed as different species.
