Work through these after trying the questions yourself.

9.1 Rent, wages, transport costs or grants (any one).

9.2 Worker skills, nearness to customers/suppliers, the owner's wishes (any one).

9.3 It falls.

9.4 Rising average cost when a firm grows too big.

9.5 It is at its lowest.

9.6 It is a *purchasing* (bulk-buying) economy of scale. Because the chain buys in huge quantities, suppliers give it large discounts, so each item costs less than it would for a small shop buying only a few — lowering the average cost per unit.
