35.1 A small molecule (such as water or HCl).

35.5 Water (or HCl).

35.6 In addition polymerisation the monomers each have a C=C double bond and simply join up with *no other product*. In condensation polymerisation the monomers each have *two* functional groups, and a small molecule (such as water) is lost at *every* new link.
