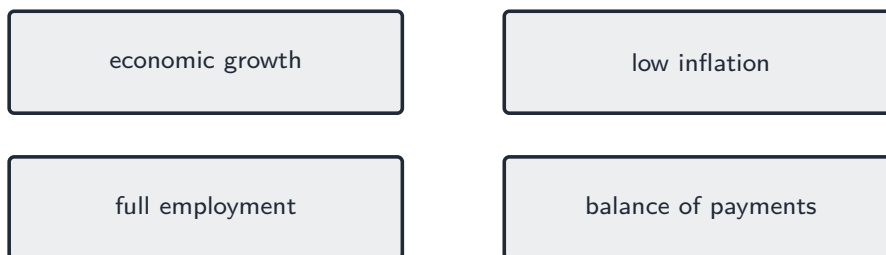

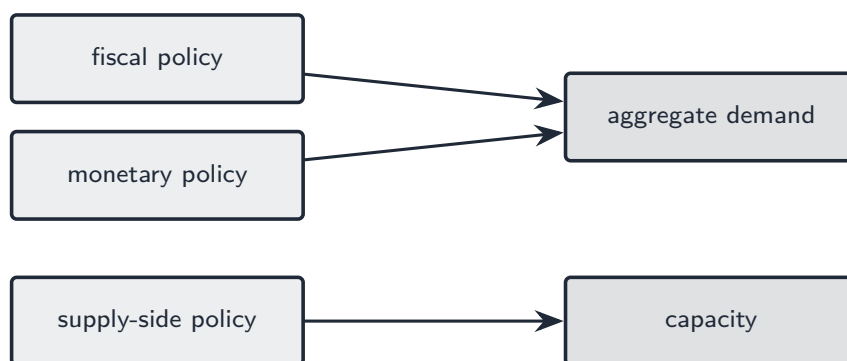

■ 1 The four objectives



Governments aim at several **macroeconomic objectives** 宏观经济目标 at once: economic growth, low **inflation** 通货膨胀, full employment, and a stable balance of payments.

■ 2 Three sets of tools



- **fiscal policy** 财政政策 — changing government spending and taxes;
- **monetary policy** 货币政策 — changing the interest rate;
- **supply-side policy** 供给侧政策 — raising the economy's capacity.

The first two work on **aggregate demand** 总需求 (quick); the third works on capacity (slow but lasting).

Watch out: fiscal (spending/taxes) and monetary (interest rate) policy act on aggregate *demand* — fast; supply-side policy raises *capacity* — slow but lasting. A government juggles several objectives that can conflict.
