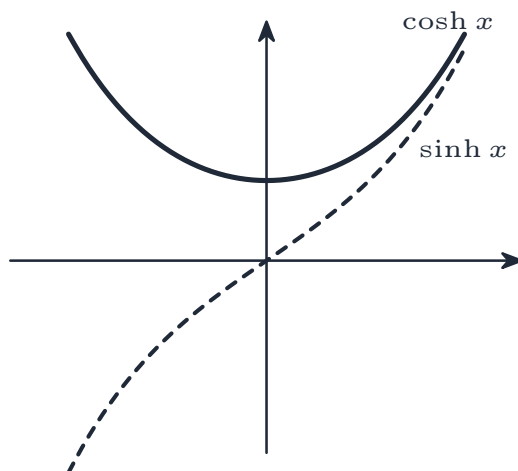

■ 1 Hyperbolic functions

The **hyperbolic functions** 双曲函数 are built from e^x :

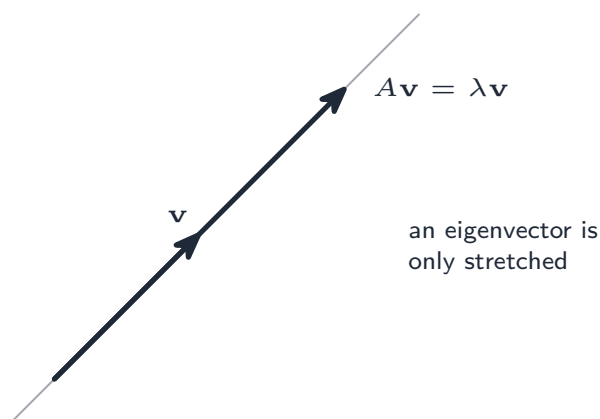


$$\cosh x = \frac{e^x + e^{-x}}{2}, \quad \sinh x = \frac{e^x - e^{-x}}{2}$$

The main identity is $\cosh^2 x - \sinh^2 x = 1$.

■ 2 Eigenvalues

For a square matrix A , an **eigenvector** 特征向量 $\mathbf{v}$ is only stretched (not turned) by A : $A\mathbf{v} = \lambda\mathbf{v}$. The number λ is an **eigenvalue** 特征值:



You find λ from the **characteristic equation** 特征方程 $\det(A - \lambda I) = 0$.

Worked example. For $A = \begin{pmatrix} 3 & 1 \\ 0 & 2 \end{pmatrix}$: $\det(A - \lambda I) = (3 - \lambda)(2 - \lambda) = 0$, so the eigenvalues are $\lambda = 3$ and $\lambda = 2$.

Watch out: the hyperbolic identity has a **minus** sign — $\cosh^2 x - \sinh^2 x = 1$ (unlike $\cos^2 x + \sin^2 x = 1$), and $\cosh x \geq 1$ always. For eigenvalues, subtract λ from the **diagonal** of A before taking the determinant.
