2.3 a gene's DNA is copied into a messenger RNA molecule (mRNA).

2.4 a codon is a group of three bases on mRNA; it codes for one amino acid.

2.5 RNA is single-stranded (DNA is double), and RNA uses the base U (uracil) instead of T.
