■ for loop

```
for (int i = 0; i < 5; i++) {  
    System.out.print(i);    // prints 01234  
}
```

The header has three parts: **initialization** (`int i = 0`), **condition** (`i < 5`), and **update** (`i++`).

■ Equivalent while

The same logic could be written as a while loop; the for loop just gathers the setup, test, and change in one place.
