Work through these after you have tried the questions yourself.

2.1 measuring the relative sizes and angles of a subject with a pencil at arm's length, to keep proportions accurate.

2.2 at the viewer's eye level.

2.3 at a single vanishing point on the horizon line.

2.4 they stay vertical; only the two sets of horizontal edges converge to the two vanishing points.

2.5 any straight-on view, e.g. a corridor, a straight road, a room seen from the doorway, railway tracks. \
