Work through these after you have tried the questions yourself.

2.1 establish the exigence; orient the reader; state the thesis.

2.2 it supplies no exigence, orients nobody, and states no position - it repeats what the reader already has.

2.3 any three of: state the consequence; state the limit; open a further question; say what follows if the argument is right.

2.4 the argument gaining something new in each paragraph.

2.5 the reader knows no more after the fourth than after the first, so the essay has length without progress. \
