**2.1** it marked a break with existing Christian traditions; both reformations contributed to the growth of Christianity.

**2.2** it gave authority over church appointments and lands, so the religious choice was also a political gain.

**2.3** it moved the argument from clergy to ordinary readers within weeks, making it a public dispute.

**2.4** each side had to hold and win people, so both invested in preaching, printing and schooling.

**2.5** the CED records both reformations increasing Christianity's reach rather than reducing it. \
