- 2.1** a state unable to fund itself without consent it had not previously needed.
- 2.2** the body asked to approve taxes gains the power to refuse, which it did not hold before.
- 2.3** when the existing institutions refuse or cannot deliver the reform, the question becomes who has the right to refuse.
- 2.4** the removed authority must be replaced, and legitimacy cannot be built as quickly as it was destroyed.
- 2.5** the account joins ideas to fiscal, social and political conditions, and an answer with only one explains less. \
