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### Answers

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Work through these after you have tried the questions yourself.

**2.1** stability - containing the danger of upheaval by agreement among the powers.

**2.2** borders were drawn to balance the powers against each other, so peoples could be placed under states they had not chosen.

**2.3** that institutions grown over time carry knowledge no designer possesses.

**2.4** it makes a claim about how knowledge accumulates, which must be answered with an argument rather than dismissed as interest.

**2.5** that it prevented a general European war for decades; that it did so by ignoring national claims. \
