Work through these after you have tried the questions yourself.

2.1 that a people sharing language, culture or history should govern themselves.

2.2 it built where the existing state did not match the national claim and could be unified, and broke where one state contained several claims.

2.3 any three of: schooling; conscription; standard languages; official histories.

2.4 teaching one language and one history to everyone produces the shared culture that the claim assumed already existed.

2.5 much of the shared culture it appealed to was produced by the states that made the appeal. \
