

Most points on this exam sit on a graph, and most lost points are a missing label or a long-run curve that is not vertical. Everything below is a rule the readers apply. 本科多数分数在图上, 失分多因缺标注或长期曲线画成斜的。

The graphs – where most points are won and lost

✗ Drawing a graph with unlabelled axes.

✓ **Label both axes, every curve, and the equilibrium point, using the standard abbreviations.**

The guidelines award graph points for specific labelled features; an unlabelled curve earns nothing.

✗ Drawing the shift and not marking the new equilibrium.

✓ **Show the shift AND the resulting change, with arrows and new labels.**

The second point is almost always for the RESULT of the shift, stated on the graph.

✗ Drawing a long-run curve that slopes.

✓ **A long-run aggregate supply curve, and a long-run Phillips curve, are VERTICAL.**

The guidelines state the curve must be vertical, at full-employment output or the natural rate of unemployment.

SG 3 years

✗ Placing the long-run curve wherever the new equilibrium falls.

✓ **Put it at full-employment output, and label that output – the gap between it and the current equilibrium is the point.**

The guidelines specify the curve's position relative to the current output, and the label Y_F .

✗ Answering a graph question in prose alone.

✓ **Draw it. Then say in words what the graph shows.**

The drawing and the explanation are separately scored, and a description cannot earn the graph points.

SG 2 years

✗ Writing 'it increases' with no direction on the graph.

✓ **Say which curve moves, which way, and what happens to price and quantity.**

Each of those is a component the readers look for by name.

■ Where a question says 'using a correctly labeled graph', the labels are part of the requirement – not decoration.

2 · Economic Indicators and the Business Cycle 经济指标与经济周期

✗ Counting an intermediate good, or a transfer payment, in GDP.

✓ **GDP counts FINAL goods and services produced within the country in the period.**

Each exclusion is a standard multiple-choice discriminator.

✗ Calling someone without a job unemployed.

✓ **They must be actively seeking work to be in the labour force.**

The definition decides the rate, and discouraged workers are the standard trap.

✗ Comparing nominal GDP across years.

✓ **Use REAL GDP – nominal changes include price changes.**

The distinction is the reason the deflator exists.

3 · National Income and Price Determination 国民收入与价格决定

✗ Shifting aggregate demand for a change in the price level.

✓ **A price-level change is a MOVEMENT ALONG the curve; only the other determinants shift it.**

This is the same along-versus-shift distinction as in microeconomics, and it decides the whole answer.

✗ Using the spending multiplier where the tax multiplier applies.

✓ **The tax multiplier is smaller and has the opposite sign, because part of a tax cut is saved.**

The two are computed from the same MPC and give different answers.

4 · Financial Sector 金融部门

✗ Shifting the money supply curve when the central bank changes the policy rate.

✓ **Show what the guidelines ask for: a change in the administered rates producing a change in the policy rate.**

The guidelines describe both routes; the graph must match the mechanism the question names.

✗ Confusing the loanable funds market with the money market.

✓ **Loanable funds sets the REAL interest rate; the money market sets the NOMINAL rate.**

The axes differ, and using the wrong graph loses every point on it.

5 · Long-Run Consequences of Stabilization Policies 稳定政策的长期影响

✗ Saying expansionary policy raises output in the long run.

✓ **In the long run output returns to Y_F and only the price level is higher.**

The long-run neutrality result is what the vertical curve encodes.

✗ Placing the short-run Phillips curve without an expected inflation rate.

✓ **Label the expected inflation rate and the natural rate of unemployment.**

The guidelines require both labels for the point.

6 · Open Economy – International Trade and Finance 开放经济 —— 国际贸易与金融

✗ Saying a stronger currency helps exporters.

✓ **An appreciation makes exports dearer abroad and imports cheaper at home.**

The direction is the whole content of the question.

✗ Confusing the current account with the financial account.

✓ **They move in opposite directions: a current-account deficit is matched by a financial-account surplus.**

The identity is examinable and makes the sign of one follow from the other.

■ Where a question chains parts – a policy, its effect on the graph, then on a second market – carry your own answer forward. Later points are awarded on consistency.

SG 2 years

1 · Basic Economic Concepts 基本经济概念

✗ Explaining a production possibilities curve's shape by saying resources are limited.

✓ **It bows outward because resources are not equally suited to both goods, so opportunity cost rises.**

The shape encodes increasing opportunity cost, which is the concept being tested.

曲线外凸是机会成本递增

CED 1.2

✗ Saying a point inside the curve is impossible.

✓ **It is attainable but INEFFICIENT – resources are unemployed or misallocated.**

Inside, on and outside the curve each mean something different, and the question always names one.

曲线内是可达但低效

✗ Treating an increase in the labour force as a movement along the curve.

✓ **More resources shift the whole curve outward.**

The along-versus-shift distinction runs through the entire course.

2 · Economic Indicators and the Business Cycle 经济指标与经济周期

✗ Calling any rise in prices inflation.

✓ **Inflation is a sustained rise in the GENERAL price level, measured by a price index.**

A single price change is a relative price change, which does the opposite work in the model.

✗ Ignoring the base year when using a price index.

✓ **An index is relative to its base; a value of 120 means 20% above the base year.**

The base is what makes the number interpretable, and calculations depend on it.

指数要看基期

3 · National Income and Price Determination 国民收入与价格决定

✗ Saying a recessionary gap means output is above full employment.

✓ **A recessionary gap is output BELOW Y_F ; an inflationary gap is above it.**

Naming the gap wrongly reverses every policy recommendation that follows.

✗ Recommending a policy without saying which tool and which direction.

✓ **Name it precisely: ‘increase government spending’, ‘lower the policy rate’.**

The readers score the specific action, not the intention behind it.

4 · Financial Sector 金融部门

✗ Saying a bank can lend all of its deposits.

✓ **It must hold reserves; the rest can be lent, and the money multiplier follows from that fraction.**

The reserve requirement is what limits the expansion, and the question always supplies it.

✗ Confusing the nominal and real interest rate in a calculation.

✓ **Real is approximately nominal minus expected inflation.**

The Fisher relation is examinable and decides which rate a decision depends on.

6 · Open Economy – International Trade and Finance 开放经济 —— 国际贸易与金融

✗ Saying a country should produce a good because it can make more of it.

✓ **Compare opportunity costs – that is what comparative advantage means.**

Absolute and comparative advantage give different answers, and trade follows the second.

✗ Analysing an exchange-rate change without saying which currency's market you are drawing.

✓ **Label the market – the demand for and supply of that currency – before shifting anything.**

Every appreciation is also a depreciation of something, so the market must be named.
