When two things happen, we can list all the outcomes to find a probability.

■ 1 Sample space

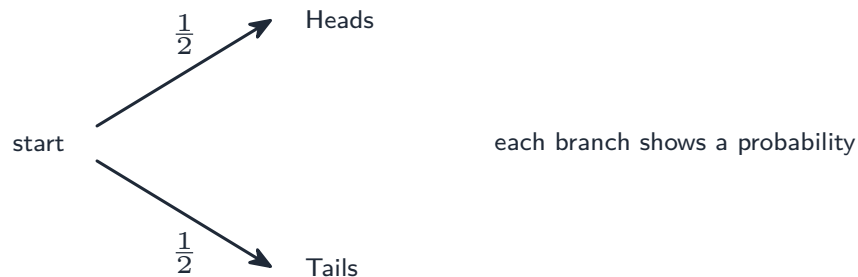
A **sample space** 样本空间 lists every possible outcome. For two dice, a grid shows all 36 sums:

You can count outcomes from the grid (for example, there are 6 ways to score a sum of 7).

■ 2 Tree diagrams

A **tree diagram** 树状图 shows the outcomes as branches, each with its probability:



Watch out: a **sample space** lists *every* outcome — count from it carefully (two dice have $6 \times 6 = 36$ outcomes, not 12). On a **tree diagram** the numbers on the branches are the probabilities.
